### WHAT IS FREE ROAM VIRTUAL REALITY?

Free roam virtual reality (VR) refers to a type of immersive experience where participants can move freely within a physical space while wearing VR headsets and interact with a virtual environment.

Players wear wireless VR headsets equipped with tracking technology that allows them to move around the arena without being restricted by cables. Sensors placed in the physical space track the movements of the participants and their interactions with the virtual environment, allowing for real-time synchronisation between the physical and virtual world.

Adelaide XR Lounge at The District offers a growing number of games designed specifically for free roam virtual reality technology.

### WHO IS ADELAIDE XR LOUNGE?

Adelaide XR Lounge is an Adelaide-based Virtual Reality (VR) provider that uses Zero Latency VR. Zero latency VR is in over 25 countries and is known as the world's greatest virtual reality experience.

### HOW MANY PEOPLE CAN PLAY AT ONCE?

Up to 8 people can play at one time.

### WHO CAN'T PLAY?

For safety reasons, individuals with the following impairments or medical conditions are unable to participate:

- Epilepsy or similar seizure disorders
- Broken leg or arm
- Deafness or severe hearing loss (exceptions may be possible, please inquire)
- Wheelchair users (exceptions may be possible, please inquire)

Our experiences are not recommended for individuals with the following medical conditions:

- Heart conditions
- Pregnancy - We advise against participation for individuals in their second or third trimester due to significant changes in balance, which poses a safety risk. Please contact us for further clarification.

### Alcohol Limit Policy:

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all participants, it is a requirement that individuals participating in our free roam VR experience must be under the legal limit for alcohol consumption. While we do not have the means to conduct on-site alcohol testing, we rely on visual cues to assess the sobriety of players.

If individuals appear visibly intoxicated or impaired upon arrival, we reserve the right to refuse entry to the VR experience. Our priority is to maintain a safe environment for all players and staff members. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in adhering to this policy.

### HOW LONG ARE SESSIONS?

Sessions are 30 minutes. You can mix and match 2 games (15 minutes each) or play a single game for the full time period (30 minutes).

For the optimal experience, Adelaide XR Lounge recommends using contact lenses. However, players can often wear glasses with a small frame. Please note: Adelaide XR Lounge cannot guarantee VR headsets to accommodate glasses of any size due to the limited space between the eyes and VR lenses.
